

Waihonua is all things in absolute balance.*

The name translates as “waters of the earth.” Fitting, as this area was once made up of ponds that produced fish with salt pans and taro fields on the horizon. And today, the ocean still washes onto the shore nearby. The memory of our kūpuna or Hawaiian ancestors lives on in Waihonua’s landscape. The entry is a contemporary interpretation of the ponds that were used to raise fish in this very spot. The thriving hala fronds were used to make mats. And the bountiful kukui nuts, signifying “enlightenment,” were burned to provide light for fishermen, and their oil used to preserve fishing nets. It was a place where aloha flourished and people had a special connection to the ‘āina or land, nature and each other. This, too, is being preserved and carried on with Waihonua at Kewalo.




